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10 Steps to Gain Experience as an Aesthetic Injector and Land Your Dream Job!

As an aesthetic injector you can explore the art of injections and elevate your skills to becoming a safe, confident, and sought-after aesthetic injector. Residency Aesthetics trains you to master techniques, enhance client satisfaction, and create stunning and natural transformations.

1. Check with the state you are living in as to the necessary certifications that are needed.

- Complete a nursing program and obtain your RN or NP license.
- Enroll in specialized training for aesthetic injectable procedures, such as Botox and dermal fillers.

2. Gain a Foundational Knowledge

- Learn the basic anatomy of injecting and understand facial anatomy to ensure you can safely and effectively perform injections.
- Know what to do in the event of a vascular occlusion and how to recognize it.
- Learn what tools are necessary (i.e needles, bacteriostatic water, alcohol, skin marking pens, etc..)

3. Gain Hands-On Experience

- Start by shadowing an experienced injector and working alongside them. Residency Aesthetics offers 90 days of hands on training and shadowing is included in this training.
- Start injecting family and friends to begin increasing your confidence and abilities under the watchful eye of a trained instructor. Offer a discounted service while you are still practicing.
- Conduct real patient consultations to better assess patient needs.

4. Build a Portfolio

- Document your work with before and after photos. (Be sure to have patient consent) to showcase your skills and progress.

5. Seek feedback and Always Look to Improve

- Ask for feedback during your training and from mentors you respect to identify areas for improvement or ways to improve your technique.

6. Leverage Social Media

- Use social media platforms to showcase your work and your new found skill. This is an excellent way to get in front of potential employers.
- Join social groups where other injectors are collaborating and networking.

7. Network and apply for jobs.

- Join an aesthetic recruitment or staffing agency for part time or permanent employment.
- Seek internships or lower entry positions within medspas with potential to move into an injector position.

8. Keep Training

- Continue to learn. The field of aesthetic injecting is ever changing. Keep up to date on latest trends and tips.





9. Establish Accounts with Product Reps

- Learn who the product reps are in your area. This can easily be done by contacting the correct companies in your area.
- Only purchase from company reps directly. Example: Botox is made by Allergan, Inc., an AbbVie company. Other places will contact you, but if they are not from Allergan, you are buying FALSE products and subject to legal ramifications. Just don't do it!

10. Stay Positive

- Nothing happens overnight. Even the success stories you think happened overnight had blood, sweat, and tears in the background.
- The industry is NOT Saturated!
- There are 333+ million people in the US alone. Roughly 7.4 million receive aesthetic procedures. That still leaves A LOT of people looking to receive. There is a surge in minimally invasive and non surgical treatments by 14% growth by 2026 due to this expanding patient growth. CAGR 12% in our industry by 2025.
